Is the home on municipal water or sewer?

Will your home require a new well or septic system?

Are you buying in a zone with a well first policy?

If you are purchasing vacant property or are planning to demo and rebuild:

- Get a <u>Site Evaluation</u> from the health department!
- Learn if the property meets
 Sanitary Code requirements &
 what type of septic system it may
 qualify for.
- Learn the depths of other wells in the area.
- Learn about subdivision and condominium requirements.

The Health Department can provide historic well records and septic permits for your property of interest.

Do you want to make an addition to or replace the existing home or add an accessory building?

- Get an Existing System

 Evaluation from the Health
 Department!
- Learn what your septic system and well can currently support and where upgrades or new septic systems may be needed.

Do you live in an area with a Well First Policy?

- Sections 3, 4, 5, and 8 of Custer township may have TCE contamination.
- Shale makes obtaining a well difficult in Torch Lake Township south of Eastport.

If you are purchasing an existing home:

- Get an <u>Existing System Real</u>
 <u>Estate Evaluation</u> from the Health Department!
- Learn about your existing well, its conditions, and what it can support.
 - ➤ Water samples are included!
- Learn what your current septic system can support and the condition that it is in.
